

A Letter from the Mira Costa Choir Boosters

Dear Choir Families,

Welcome! We're so glad your child has chosen to participate in Mira Costa's fantastic choral program, and we're certain he or she will enjoy it and flourish as a musician and as a person under the inspired direction and leadership of Mr. Michael Hayden and Mr. Mark McCormick.

Awards and Accomplishments

The Costa choirs are award winning and highly regarded within both the academic and professional communities. Did you know...

- Mira Costa Choir students are accepted into the most prestigious universities in the country: Yale, Princeton, UC Berkeley, UCLA, USC, Boston College, NYU, Michigan, Baylor, Wellesley, New England Conservatory, Claremont Colleges, Rochester, and many more, participating in the university choral programs and becoming leaders in those choral ensembles.
- Our 2017 festival choir toured the Rhine River from Amsterdam, Netherlands, to Basel, Switzerland, performing in Cologne Cathedral, Strasbourg Cathedral, St. Maria Himmelfahrt, and others.
- Our 2015 festival choir participated in a Paris-London tour, performing in Notre Dame Cathedral, Canterbury Cathedral, St. Georges Chapel at Windsor Castle, Grosvenor Chapel, and others.
- In 2015, we were one of only three high school choirs in the nation selected to perform at the American Choral Directors' Association National Convention in Salt Lake City, Utah. In 2012, we were one of three high school choirs selected to perform at the ADCA Regional Conference in Reno, Nevada.
- Women's Choir has won Best Women's and Best Overall choir at Disneyland's Music in the Parks Festival the past three years, and Men's Choir has won Best Men's and Best Overall the past two years.
- We have been the featured choir in the Walt Disney Concert Hall, singing a solo set in the LA Master Chorale's High School Festival.
- Our singers were the featured choir the National Youth Honor Choir in Carnegie Hall in 2012.
- We have students selected to participate in Southern California Vocal Assoc. Honor Choirs every year.
- We were named one of only 3 GRAMMY® Award Winning Signature Gold Schools in the country in 2014. The GRAMMY® Foundation rewarded these top high schools for their total music program curriculum and performance opportunities.
- We are the first high school department to participate with Vox Femina, Los Angeles' premiere community Women's Choir.
- In 2014, the Advanced Women's Chorale was the first choir to perform at the prestigious California Teacher of the Year Gala in Sacramento, where Mr. Hayden was honored as one of five California Teachers of the Year, the first choral director to be given that statewide honor.
- Mr. McCormick was named a Sandacre Teacher of the Year in 2014, an award voted on by the senior class recognizing the senior classes' favorite teachers.

Funding

As you might imagine, a lot of time, work and resources go into making choir one of the most positive and enriching experiences available at Mira Costa High School, and **we need your help**. The funding received from MBUSD is extremely limited and does not come close to covering the actual operating expenses of the choir program. That's where the Choir Boosters come in. In addition to providing Mr. Hayden with the administrative and organizational support he needs to run the program, we exist to raise funds that allow your child to have an extraordinary choral experience. In fact, over half the cost of our high quality program is paid for by the Choir Boosters.

Without parent contributions, many of the activities that make up your student's choir experience would be cut from the program (e.g., performances, festivals, our accompanist, work with expert clinicians, etc.).

What MBUSD Covers:

1. Mr. Hayden's regular salary and benefits
2. Hourly compensation for an accompanist for 4 periods
3. A choir room for class and auditorium for concerts
4. Partial funding for sheet music and continuing education

What Choir Boosters Cover (about \$60,000 over the course of the year):

1. Salary and benefits to bring Mr. McCormick's compensation to the level of a full-time teacher (\$34,500)
2. Cost of participating in choral festivals (registration, buses, snacks for the trip) (\$5,000)
3. Concerts and other choir events (\$4,000)
4. Printing costs for concert programs (\$3,500)
5. Music licensing, supplies, equipment, and piano maintenance (\$2,500)
6. Performance clothing reserve (\$3,000)
7. Clinicians (\$2,000)
8. Website, Admin (\$1,000)
9. Other expenses that arise during the year, often new performance or education opportunities (\$1,000)

We're happy to answer any questions about the budget and always appreciate your involvement and comments.

Fair Share

The biggest source of the money we raise is donations, almost all from choir families. To run our GRAMMY® award winning music program, **we are asking for a tax-deductible Fair Share contribution of \$300 for each student participating in choir.**

Checks should be made out to **MBX (and list "Choir Donation" in the memo line)**, and they can be dropped in the Booster mailbox in the choir room. Or go to the MBX website (mbxfoundation.org) under "Booster Clubs" and donate online. Throughout the year, please put your child's name and ensemble on any check you submit, and note what the check is for (e.g., choir clothes, donation, etc.).

This year, we have created four levels of tax-deductible support for the program, each with its own benefits. Please donate generously to maintain the program's excellence, now or any time during the year.

At the \$300 Bronze Level:	Your name is listed in the concert programs
At the \$500 Silver Level:	Your name is listed in the concert programs, plus 2 reserved seats and a CD for each concert
At the \$750 Gold Level:	Your name is listed in the concert programs, plus 4 reserved seats and a CD for each concert
At the \$1,000 Platinum Level:	Your name is listed in the concert programs, plus 6 reserved seats and a CD for each concert

Every parent's contribution, big or small, helps make Mira Costa Choirs one of the top programs in the state, with the individual focus that allows each of our children to grow and thrive.
